Continual research and development efforts begin to pay off for building products that are steadily gaining recognition and acceptance, and which should allow the Division to benefit from the eventual economic upturn.

The Division's pressed metal roof tile products have steadily gained greater acceptance by the building and construction industries as a lightweight, long-lasting and cost-effective roofing system. They have been well-received for use in industrial properties and plants, and by high profile condominiums and hotels. Made out of high quality galvanized zinc the tiles are either stonechip-coated or painted to various finishes to suit any building design as well as being adaptable for differing construction specifications.

The metal roof tiles' light weight and the ease involved in installing them have found growing appeal in newer markets such as South Korea, Taiwan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Maldives and Mauritius.

The roof tiles are produced at 2 locations, namely the Malaysian Roofing Industries plant in Nilai, Negeri Sembilan and the Jakarta factory operated by its subsidiary, PT Indomalay Ekatana Roofing Industries.
