K 21 March 2004

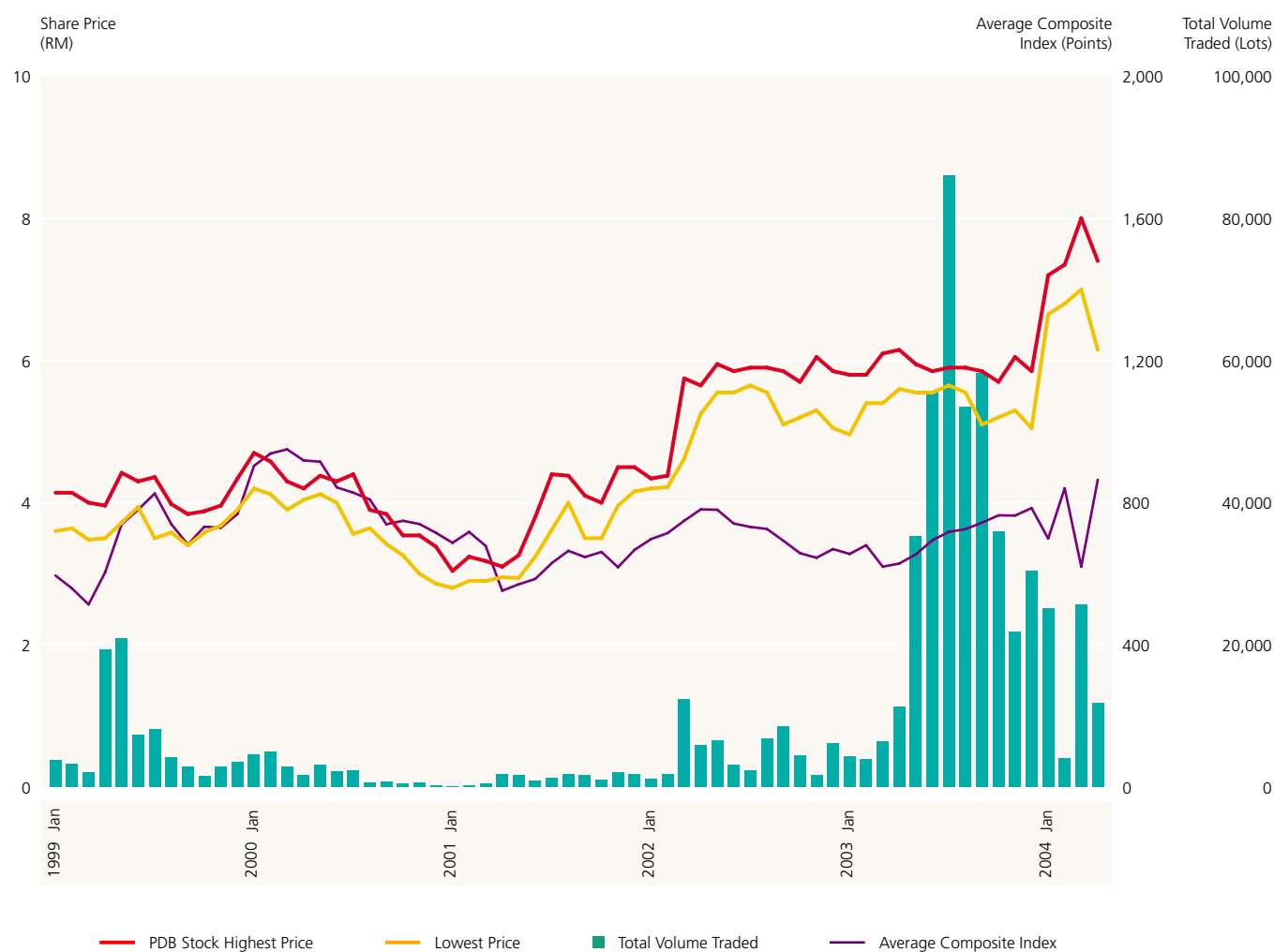

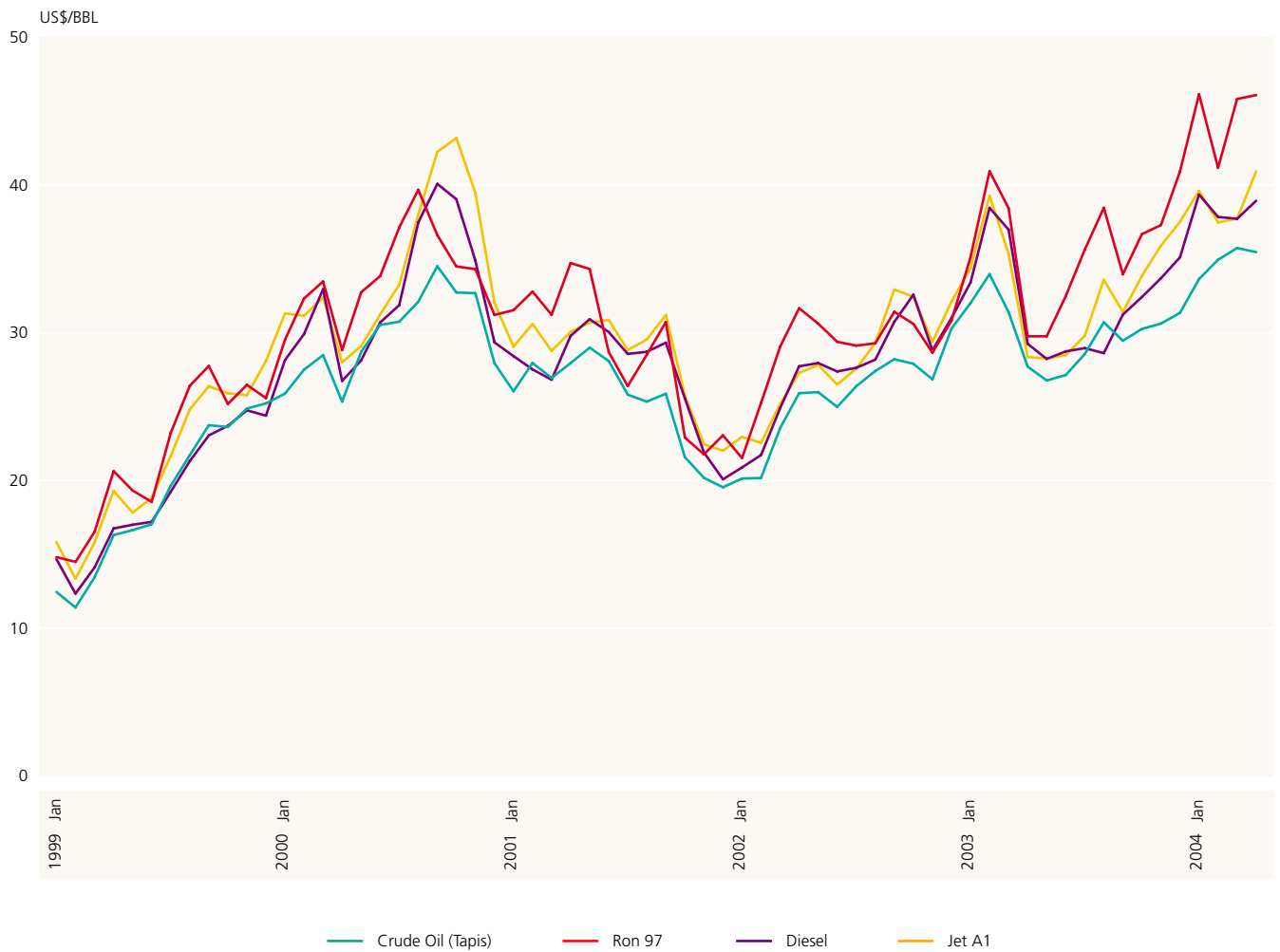
