



Tan Sri Dato Sri Mohd Hassan bin Marican, a Malaysian aged 51, was appointed as the Chairman of PETRONAS Gas Berhad (PGB) on 1 August, 1991. Beyond PETRONAS, Tan Sri Dato Sri Mohd Hassan is a board member of the Malaysia-Thailand Joint Authority, which oversees petroleum development in the overlapping area between Malaysia and Thailand. He is also a member of the International Investment Council for the Republic of South Africa established by President Thabo Mbeki.

Tan Sri Dato Sri Mohd Hassan is an Energy Governor and the current Energy Community Chairman for the World Economic Forum (WEF) as well as a member of the WEF's Council of 100 Leaders. He is also a member of the Commonwealth Business Council.

Tan Sri Dato Sri Mohd Hassan has attended three (3) Board meetings in the financial year.




Wan Zulkiflee bin Wan Ariffin

He is an executive director of Sarawak Enterprise Corporation Berhad and the Deputy Chairman of Sarawak Electricity Supply Corporation. He is also an Independent Director and Audit Committee Chairman of four other public listed companies namely, PETRONAS Dagangan Berhad, Industrial Concrete Products Berhad, Jaya Jusco Stores Berhad and PBA Holdings Berhad. He also acts as Independent Director in other public limited companies.

He was appointed to the Board of PGB on 18 March, 1999 and attended four (4) Board meetings in this financial year.



Datuk Mohd Zain bin Abdul Majid

Datuk Mohd Zain bin Abdul Majid, a Malaysian aged 65, is an Independent Non-Executive Director and a member of the Audit Committee. He graduated in Economics from the University of Glasgow and in Law from the University of London and is a Fellow of the Economic Development Institute of IBRD in Washington. He had also attended the Senior Executive Programme at London Business School.

He served for 37 years in several positions in the public and private sectors before retiring at the end of 1999. He was the Director-General of the Malaysian Industrial Development Authority, Executive Chairman of the Urban Development Authority, Chief Executive of the Malaysian Employers Federation and was executive and non-executive director of various companies in the manufacturing, finance and property sectors.
